Restricted activities for Savannah River Site (SRS) in accordance with the following writing by the COTR:

Arjun has an appearance of bias with respect to SRS for the years from the beginning of SRS operations through 1984. He is restricted from any further review work addressing this period. Arjun may work on SRS dose reconstruction site profile reviews and SRS SEC petition reviews addressing matters concerning the period beginning in 1985.

The practical implementation of this is that Arjun can work on any matters that apply to the period beginning in 1985. However, if any of the matters also have application during deliberations by the Board and NIOSH regarding an SEC petition or site profile review addressing the period for which he is found to have

an appearance of bias (prior to 1985), he may not represent SC&A on these matters in its interactions with the Board and NIOSH/DCAS. This means he can neither speak nor author or review papers addressing the period of concern.
